“Whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offends it in one point, he is **guilty** of all.”

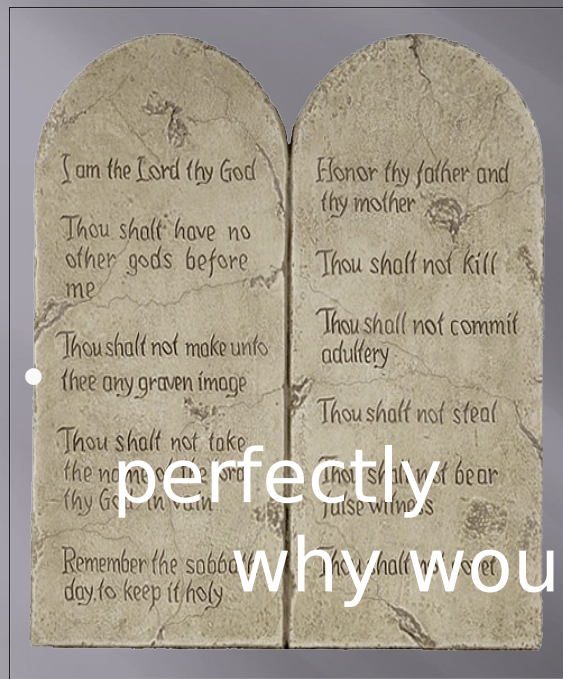
James 2:10

The Law is Merciless

The Wage of breaking one Law is Death.



Not!

What? If I kept the law

perfectly

why wouldn't that *please* God?

Because Galatians 3:12 says “that the law is not of faith” and

“without faith it is impossible to *please* God.” (Heb. 11:6)

“The law makes nothing perfect.” (Heb. 7:19) **What purpose does the law serve?**

Therefore, if you kept the law perfectly, it would not mean you were perfect. The Law works Gods wrath.” Rom. 4:15 As child who makes a perfect score, is not perfect.

The Law's Purpose



“The law is holy and just and good.” It shows God’s strict standards for perfect holiness. (Rom. 7:12)



The Law gives us an understanding of what a sin is, “for I had not known lust until the Law said, Thou shall not covet.”(Rom. 7:7)



The Law condemns to death anyone failing to obey it perfectly. Our weak flesh cannot keep it. (Rom. 7:9, 8:3)



The Law is our schoolmaster to bring us to Christ, that we might be justified by faith in the only one to satisfy its demands . (Galatians 3:10-13)

Many preach that you fall from grace by sinning too much.

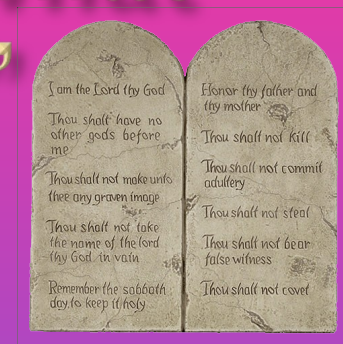
Not true!

The Law justifies no one in the sight of God. Gal. 3:11

The Law is the Administration of Death. 2 Cor. 3:7

The Law is the Administration of Condemnation. 2 Cor. 3:8

The Law is a curse for no human can keep it. Gal. 3:10

1 Corinthians 15:56, Romans 7:8

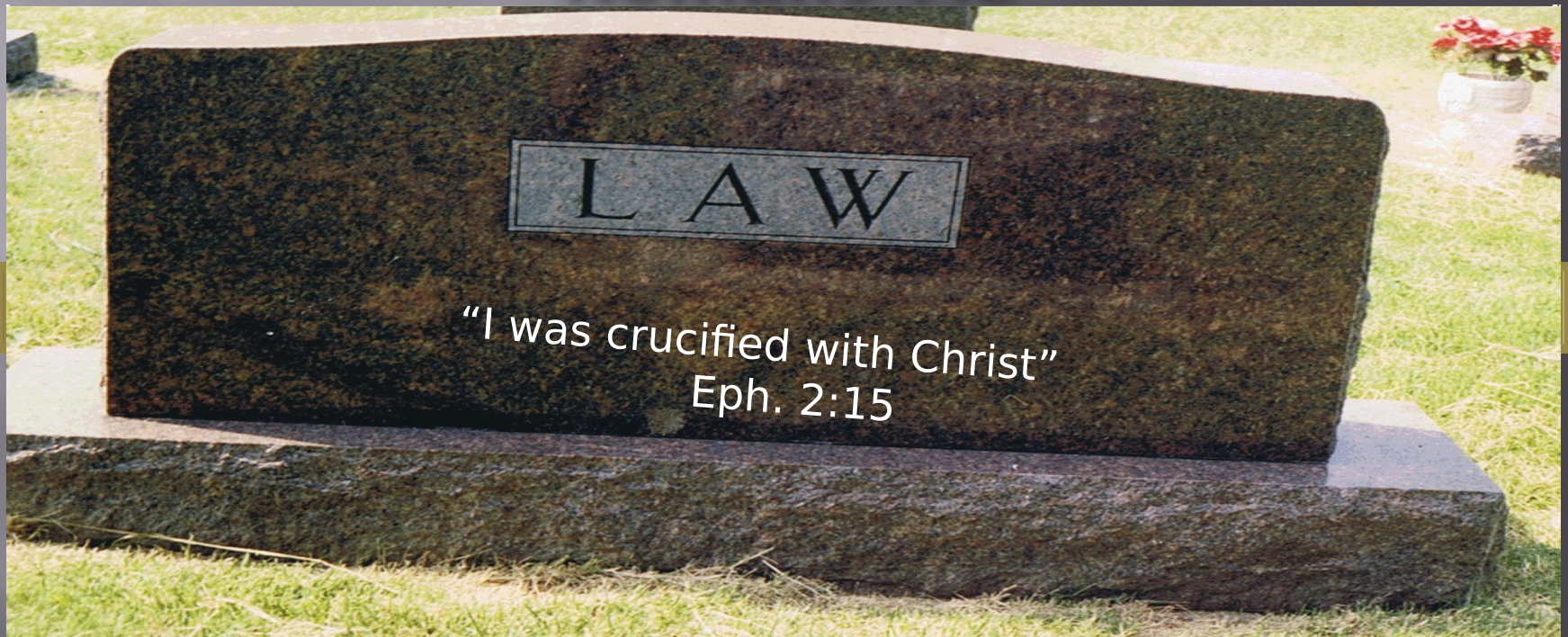
LAYING DOWN THE LAW

Christ is the end of the law for righteousness for all who believe, for if righteousness comes by the law then Christ is dead in vain. (Rom. 10:4, Gal. 2:20)

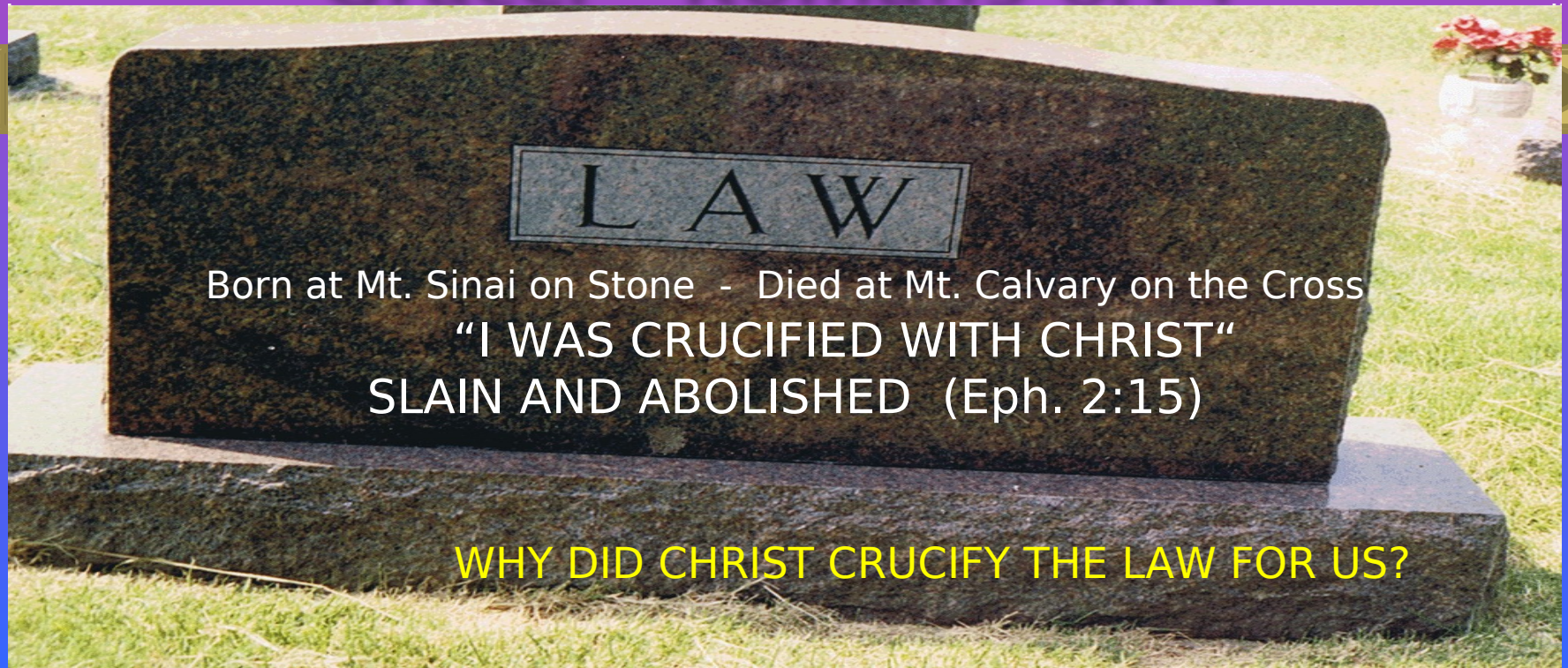

WHY DID CHRIST CRUCIFY THE LAW FOR US?

- “Without the Law sin is dead.” Romans 7:8
- “When there is no law there is no sin.” Rom. 4:15
- Sin is not imputed, charged to you, when there is no Law.” Romans

No Law of a Speed Limit, then No Offense was committed. No tickets



- “Believers are literally saved by grace as the “blessed whom the Lord will not impute, count, sin. For sin is not imputed, charged, unless you are under the law, and ye are not under the law, but under grace. ” Has any preacher ever told you that sin has been dead over 2,000 years? (Romans 4:7-8, 6:14)

What then, shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? God forbid.

1. “Brethren you have been called unto liberty, only use not your liberty as an occasion to the flesh but by love serve one another.”
2. Though the law has been satisfied & crucified, the redeemed have been given “instructions in righteousness” to become Christ’s disciples.
3. “If you be without chastisement then are you bastards and not children of the Most High.” God does supply discipline to His unruly children.

Yeah, yeah, yeah, but what does “God forbid” mean?

The New Testament's use of "God forbid" is not an American Slang or Colloquialism

"God forbid" does not mean:

Paul was not using God's Name in Vain

hope not."
"Heavens no!"
surely not!"
"Of course not!"
"Surely not!"
"Perish the thought."
"Far be the thought!"

"Certainly not!"
"May it never
"Let's
"No,

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"By no means."

When Compared to other Scriptures Scripture Interprets Itself

“Is Christ the minister of sin? God forbid.” (Gal. 2:17)

- Does not mean may it never be. It means it shall never be **God has forbidden the** possibility of Christ ministering Sin.

“Is the Law sin? God forbid.” (Romans 7:7)

- Does not mean may it never be. It means it shall never be because **God has forbid it to be.**

“Is there unrighteousness with God? God forbid.”

(Romans 9: 14) Does not mean certainly not. It means it cannot for **God has forbid that possibility to be.**

“Shall their unbelief make God’s faith ineffective? God forbid.” (Romans 3:3) Means God has forbidden the possibility of anyone’s unbelief overthrowing His faith.

So what does “Shall we continue in sin that grace may abound? God forbid” mean?

It means God has forbidden the possibility of any believer continuing in sin, asking: “How shall we who are dead [not dying] but dead to sin live any longer therein?” Answer: Its impossible!

“In Him we live move and have our being” and “in Him is no sin.” 1st John 3:5. By the cross, not only is the believers’ sins washed away, but sin is now *dead* to us for “without the law sin is dead.” Rom. 7:8 By the cross, our old man (sinful human nature) was crucified dead with Christ, and “he that is dead is free from sin.” Rom. 6:6. “Ye are dead and your life is hid with Christ in God.” Christ *took away* the sin of the world so believers cannot continue in sin. That’s good news!

Jesus Christ Loves You!

- **“When we were sinners Christ died for us.”**
- **Christians aren't perfect, just forgiven their lifetime sins, and no new sins can be imputed unto them for “sin is not imputed when there is no law” and believers “are not under law but under grace.” “For blessed is the man unto whom the Lord will not impute sin.”**
Romans 4:7-8 Isn't that GOOD NEWS?

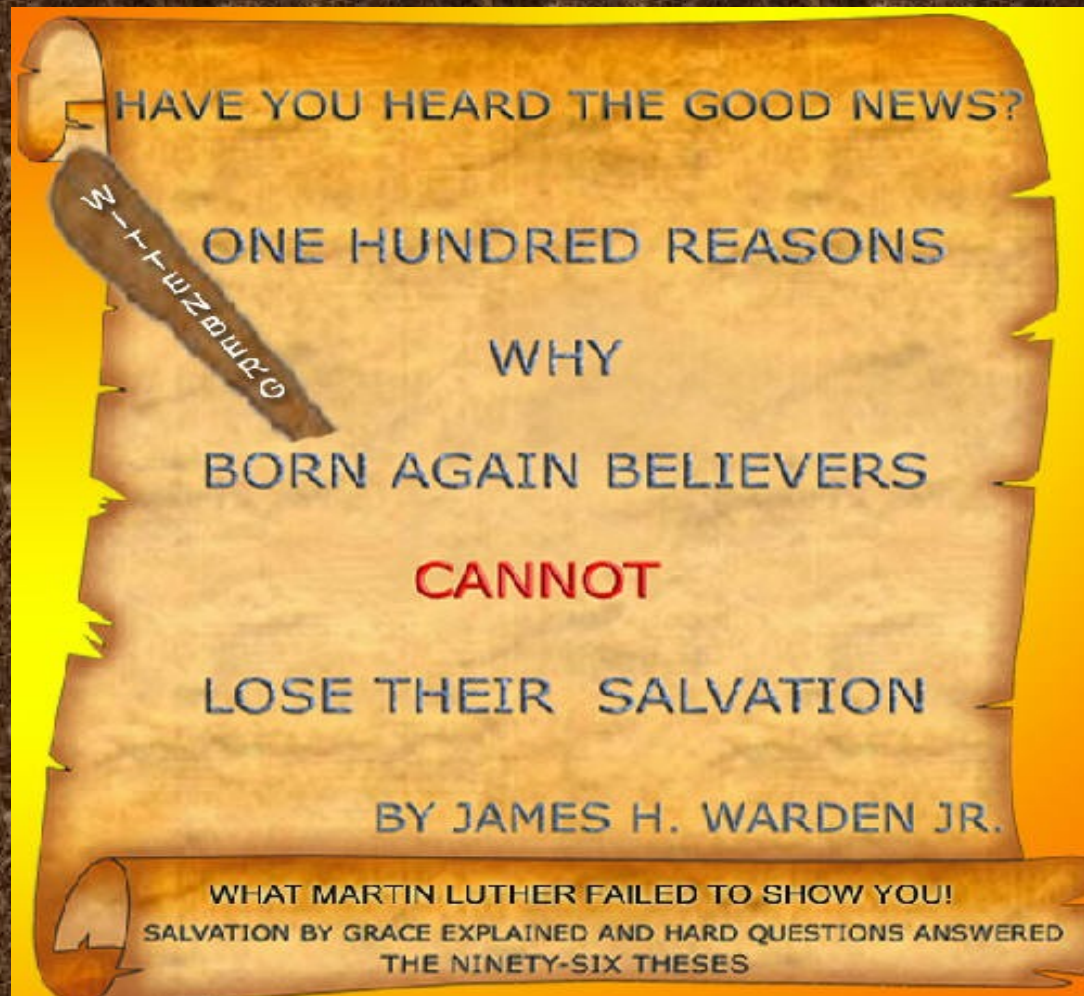
