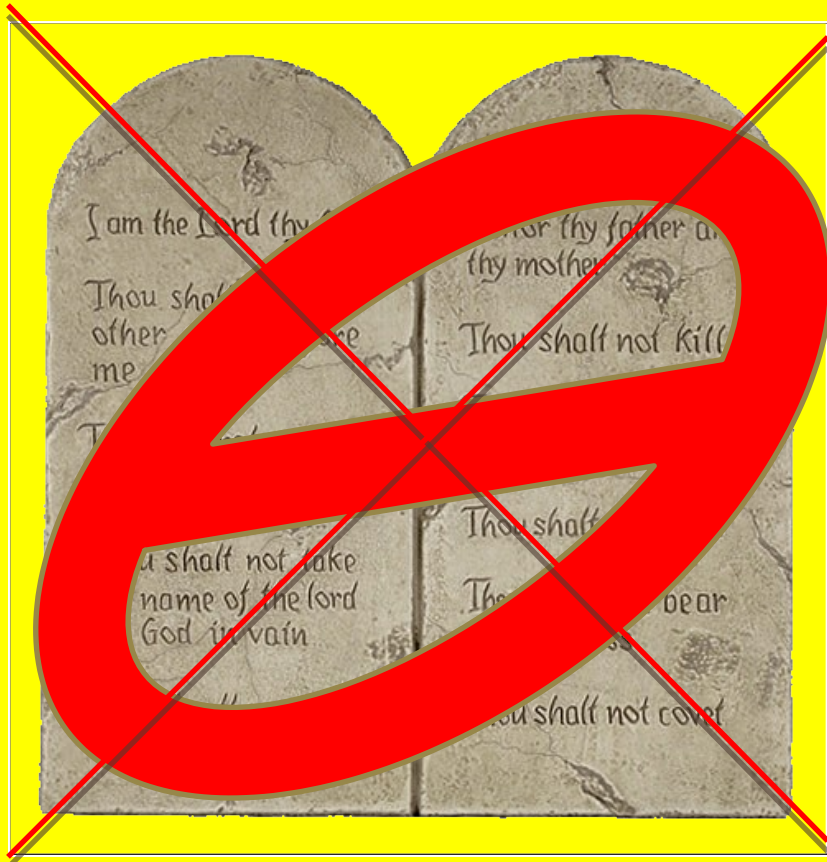
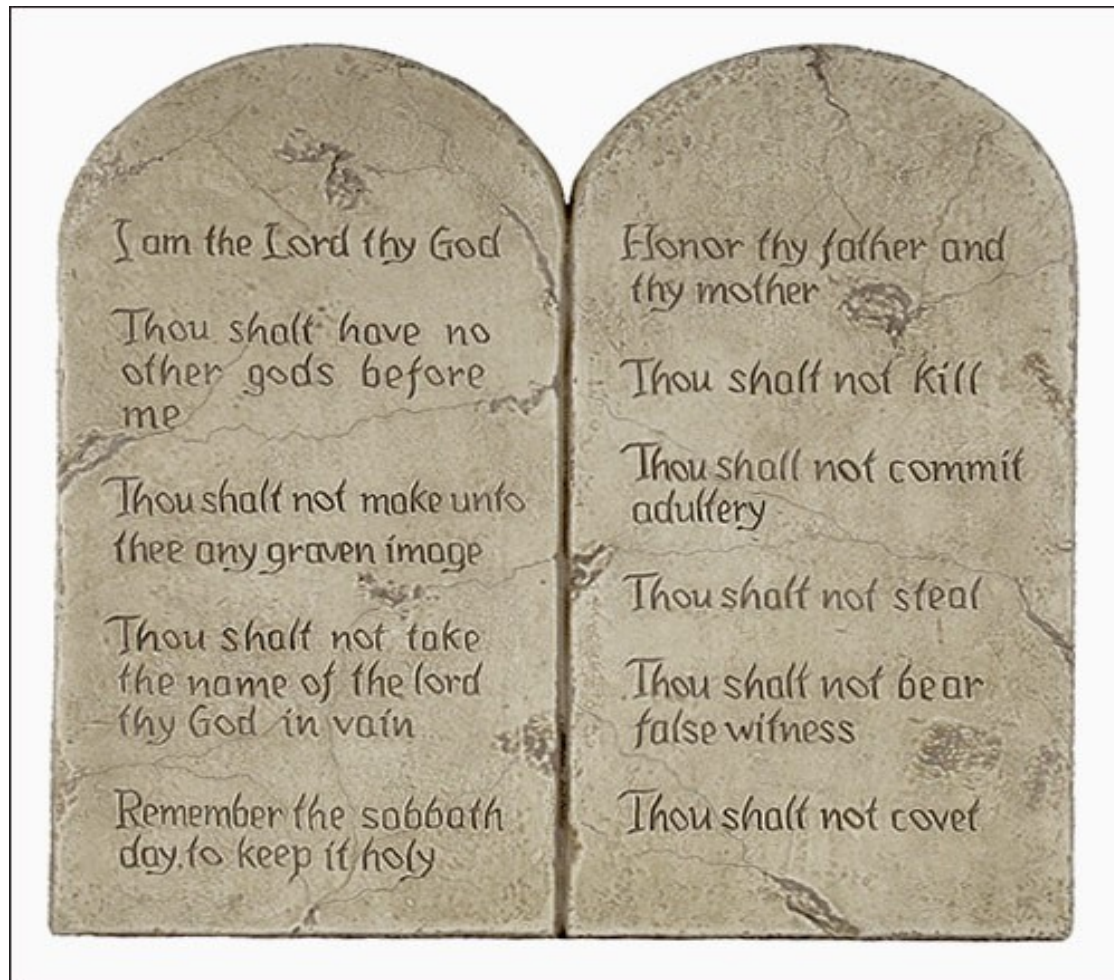

THE OLD COVENANT LAW MADE US **GUILTY** BEFORE GOD

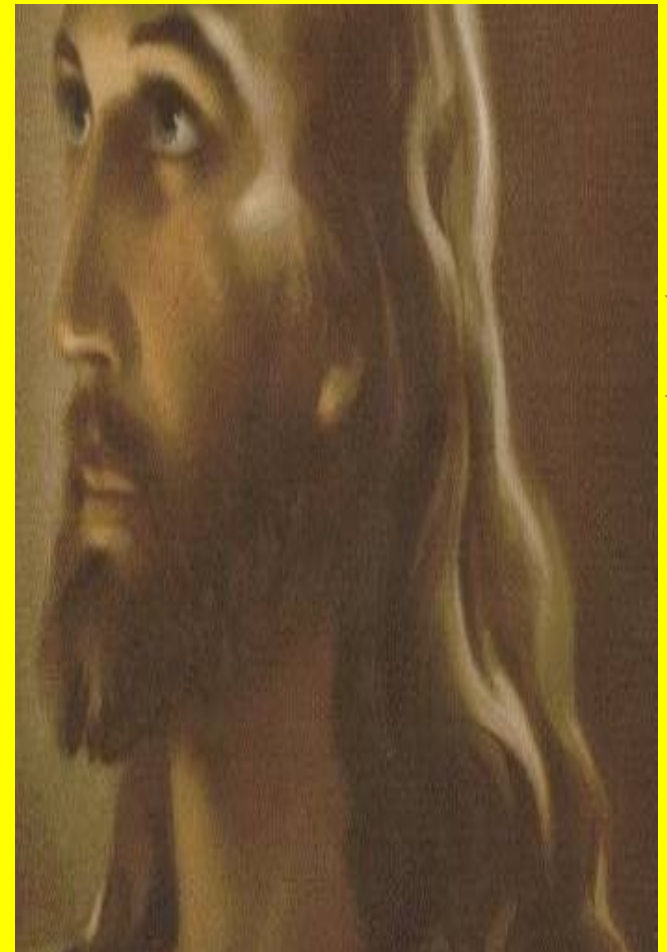


“Whosoever shall keep the whole law, yet offends it in one point, he is **guilty** of all.” James 2:10

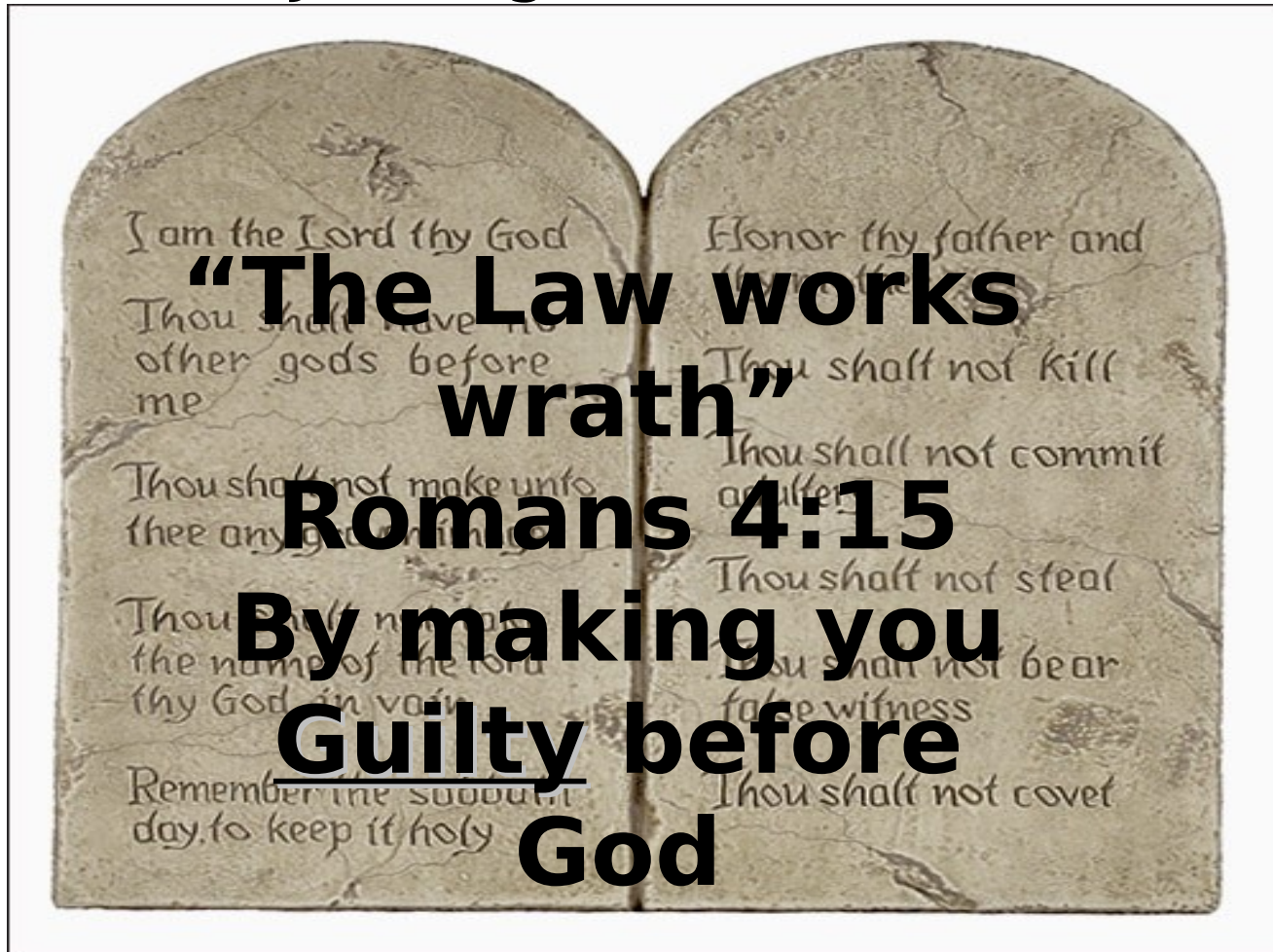
“The Law was given that every mouth would be stopped [without alibi], and that the whole world would become **guilty** before God.” Romans 3:19

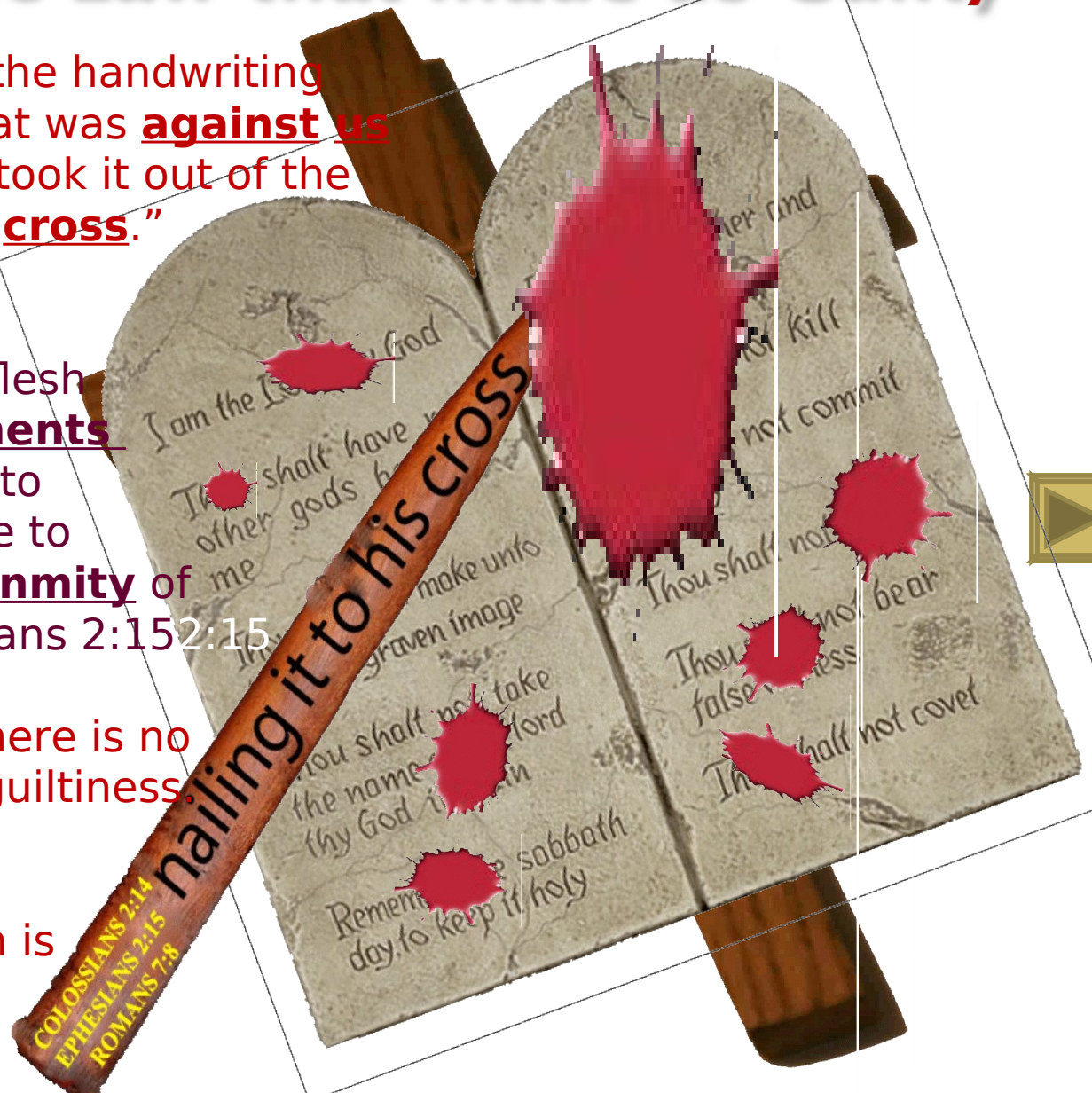
To Remove our Law Breaking Guilt, Jesus Crucified the Law that made us Guilty

Colossians 2:14

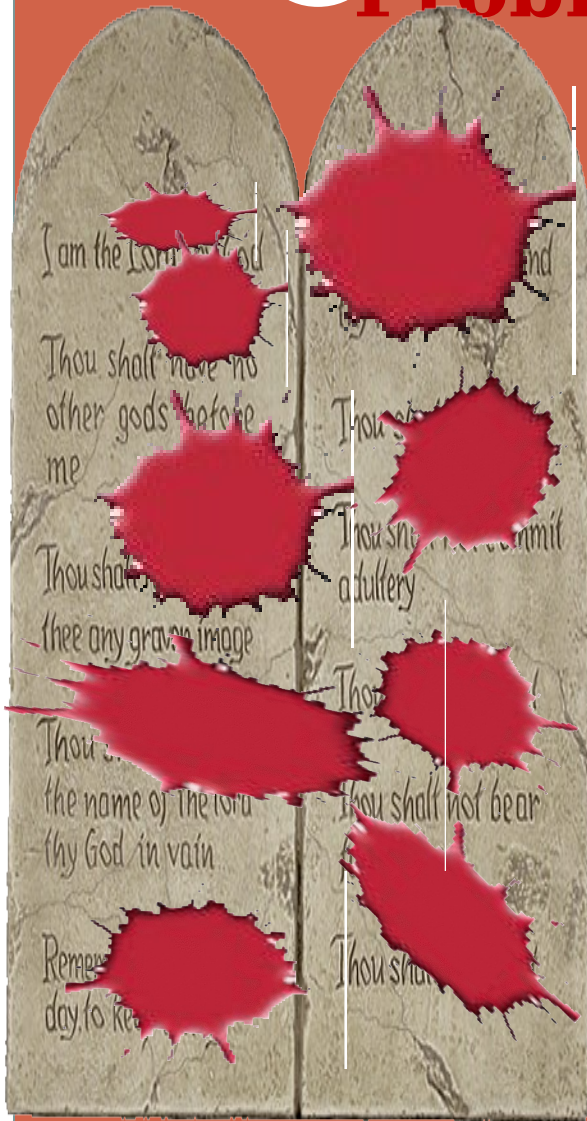

Romans 5:13



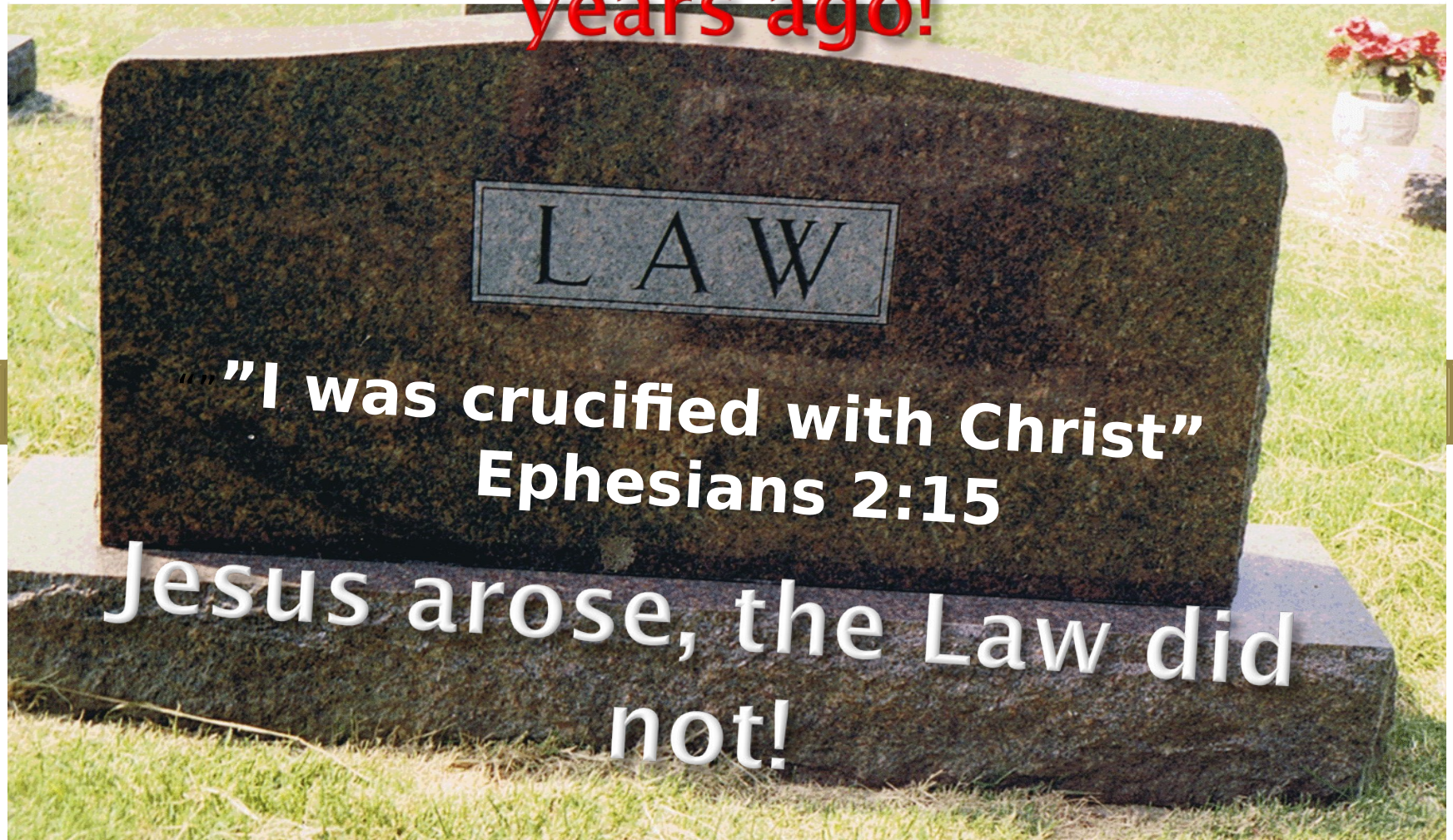
Why was the Holy Law the Problem?

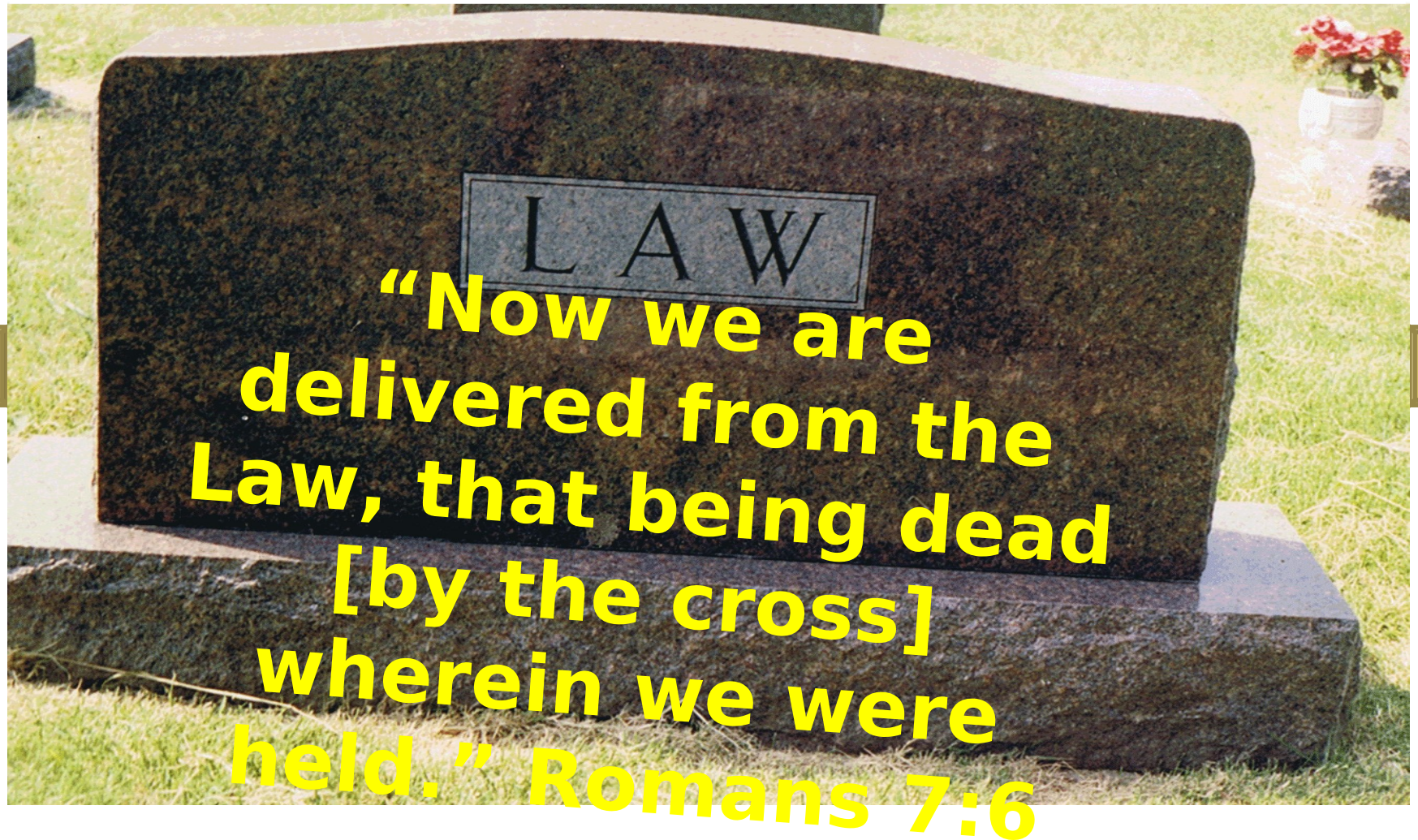

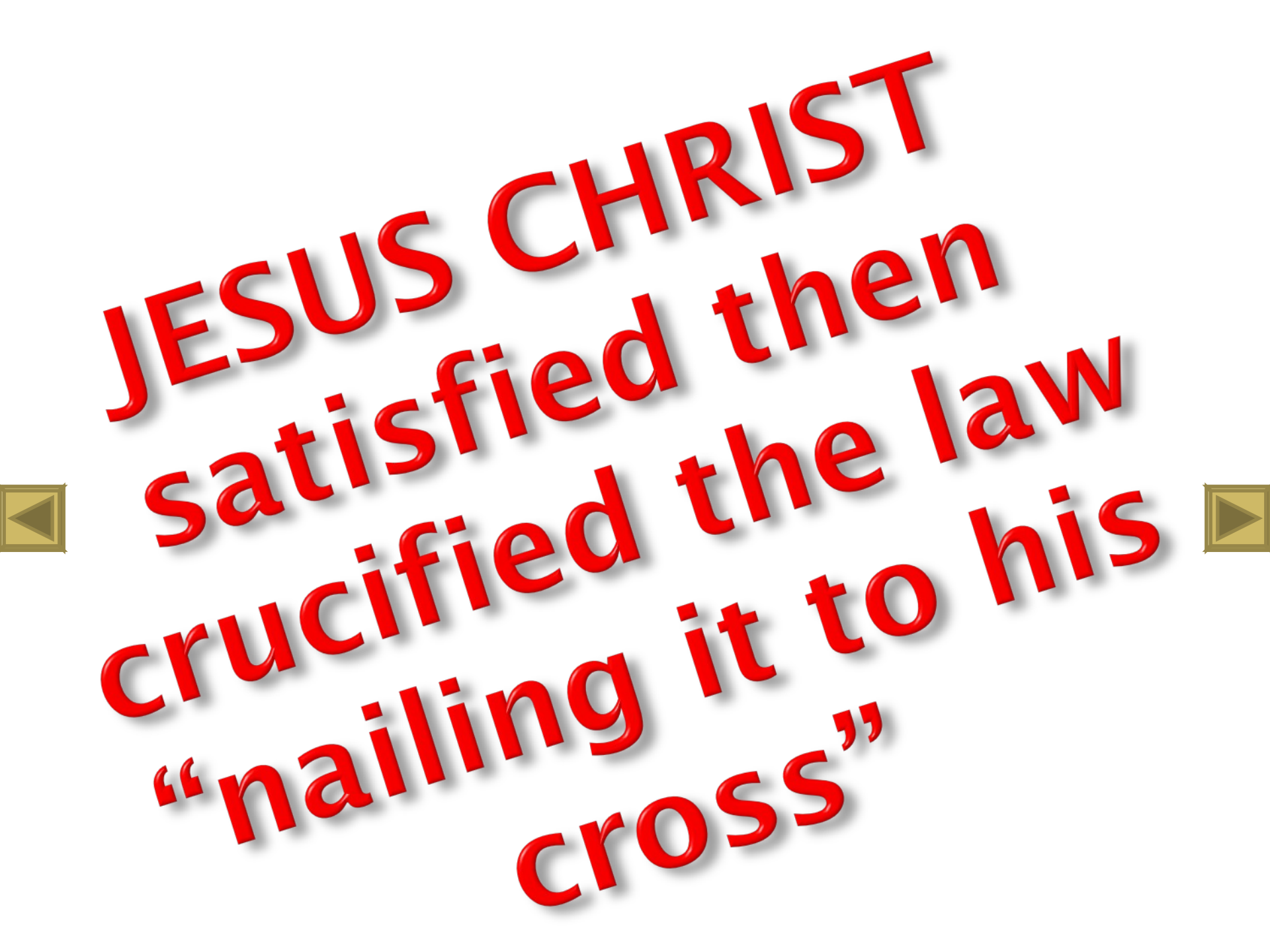

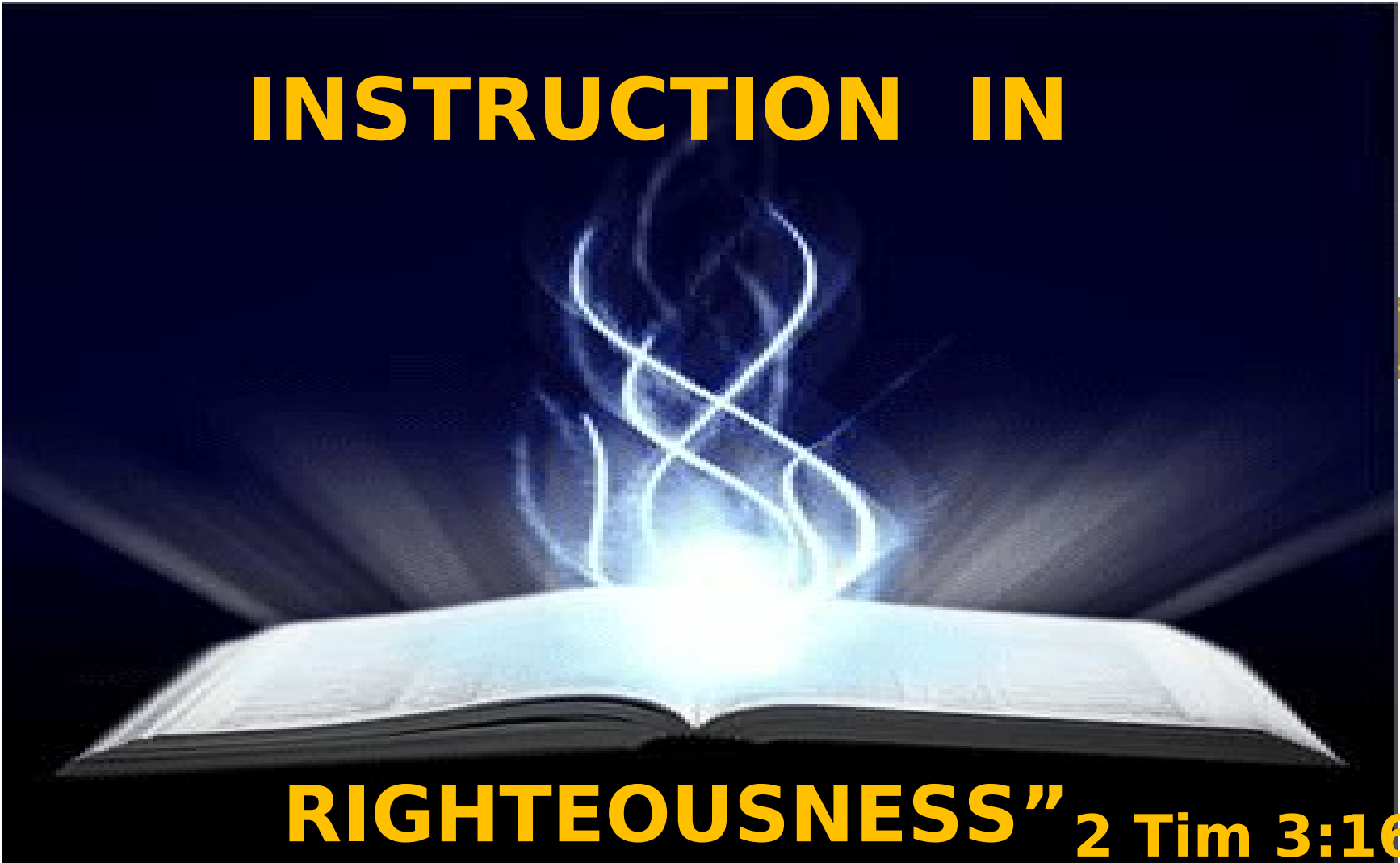

- E. Live godly in this present evil world.

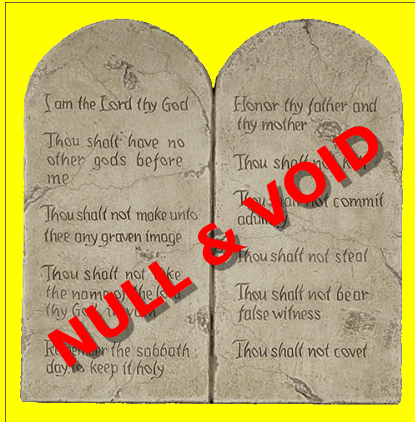

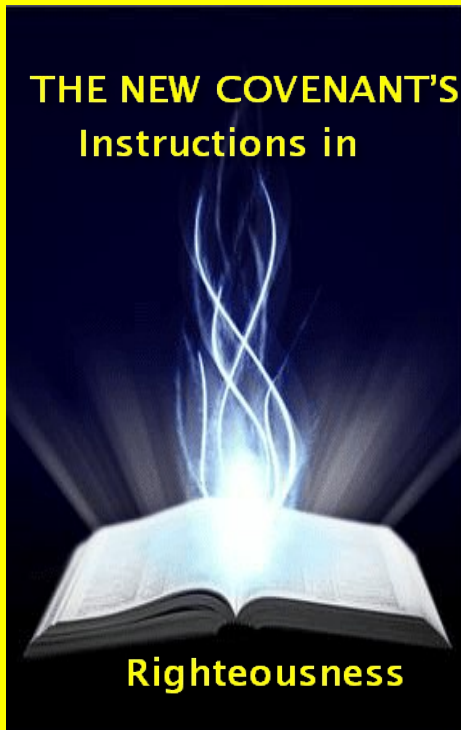

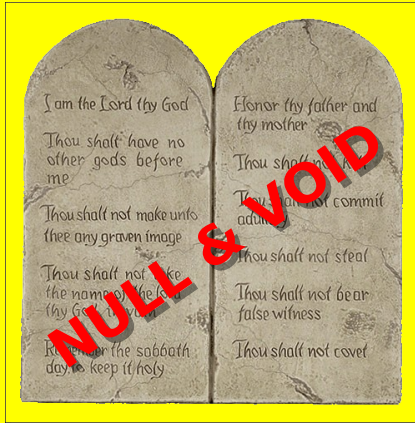


The Law states:

The Instruction in Righteousness states:

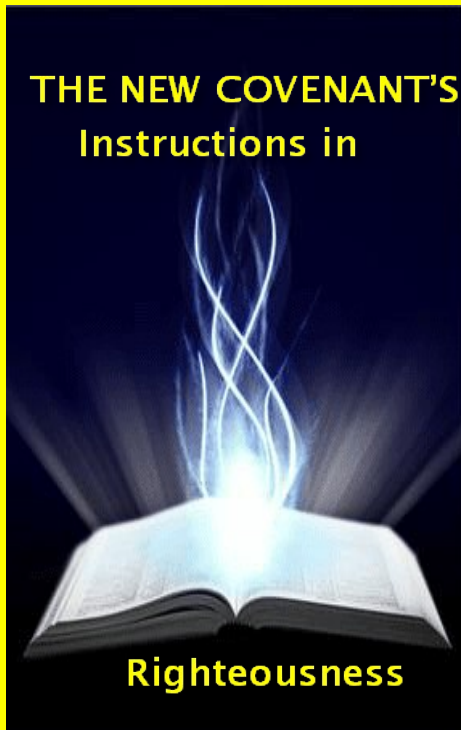

**whereas violating an instruction in
righteousness does not carry the death
penalty.**

Violating God's instruction results in a **believer's chastisement** in one of four categories:

- **faults**
- **wrongs**
- **offenses**
- **errors**

These cause Christ to have “ought against” a believer but does **not** result in the termination of their “eternal life”.

FAULTS

- PENALTY: The believer will be “buffeted” for his or her own faults. (1 Peter 2:20)
- REMEDY: “If a man be overtaken in a **fault**, ye who are spiritual restore such a one in the spirit of meekness; considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. (Gal. 6:1) Confess your **faults** one to another, and pray for one another that ye may be healed.” (James 5:16)

WRONGS

- PENALTY: “he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done.” (Col. 3:25)
For this cause many are weak and sickly and some have even died.
- REMEDY: “Trust in the Lord and do good.
- EXAMPLE: “Defraud ye not a brother for the Lord is the avenger of all such.” (1 Thes 4:6)
Delivering ones to Satan for destruction of their flesh or to teach them not to blaspheme.
1 Corinthians 5:5, 1 Timothy 1:20

OFFENSES

- PENALTY: “offenses shall come but woe to that man by whom the offense comes. (Matt 18:7)
- REMEDY: “Give no offense in anything that the ministry be not blamed. (2 Co 6:3) Give no offense to Jews, Gentiles or the church of God. (1 Co 10:32)
- EXAMPLE: Remember Ananias & Sapphira.

ERRORS

- PENALTY: to receive in oneself the recompense of their error which was meet (fitting). (Matt 18:7)
- REMEDY: “Do not err.” “If any of the brethren err from the truth, ... convert him from the error of his way.” (James 1:16, 5:19-20)
- EXAMPLE: “Ye do err not knowing the Scriptures nor the power of God. “ Mt 22:29

Warning

For them the Lord loves He corrects and He is the avenger of all such. Be not decieved God is not mocked. Whatsoever any man soweth that shall he also reap!

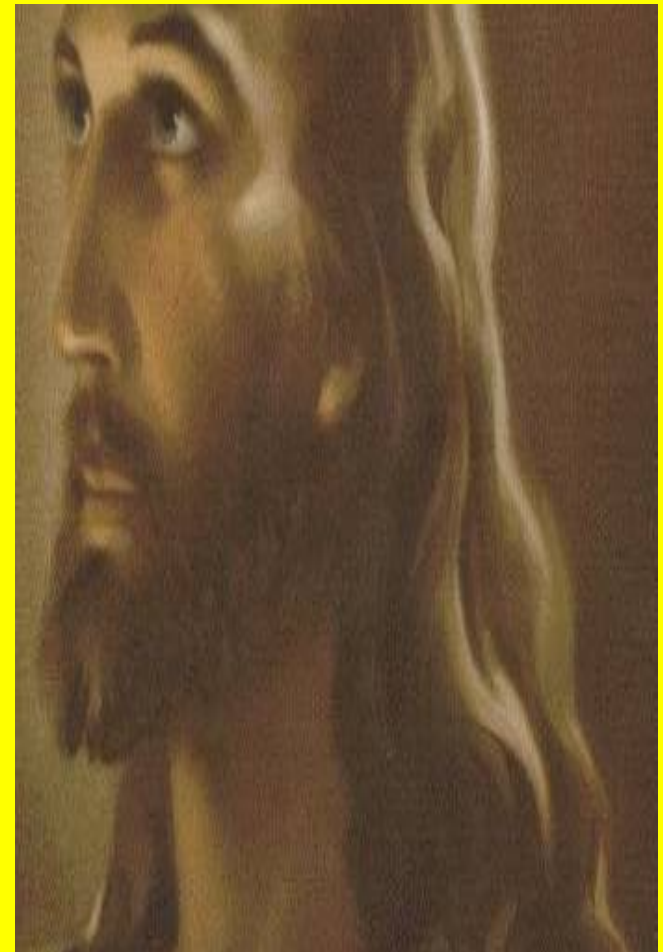

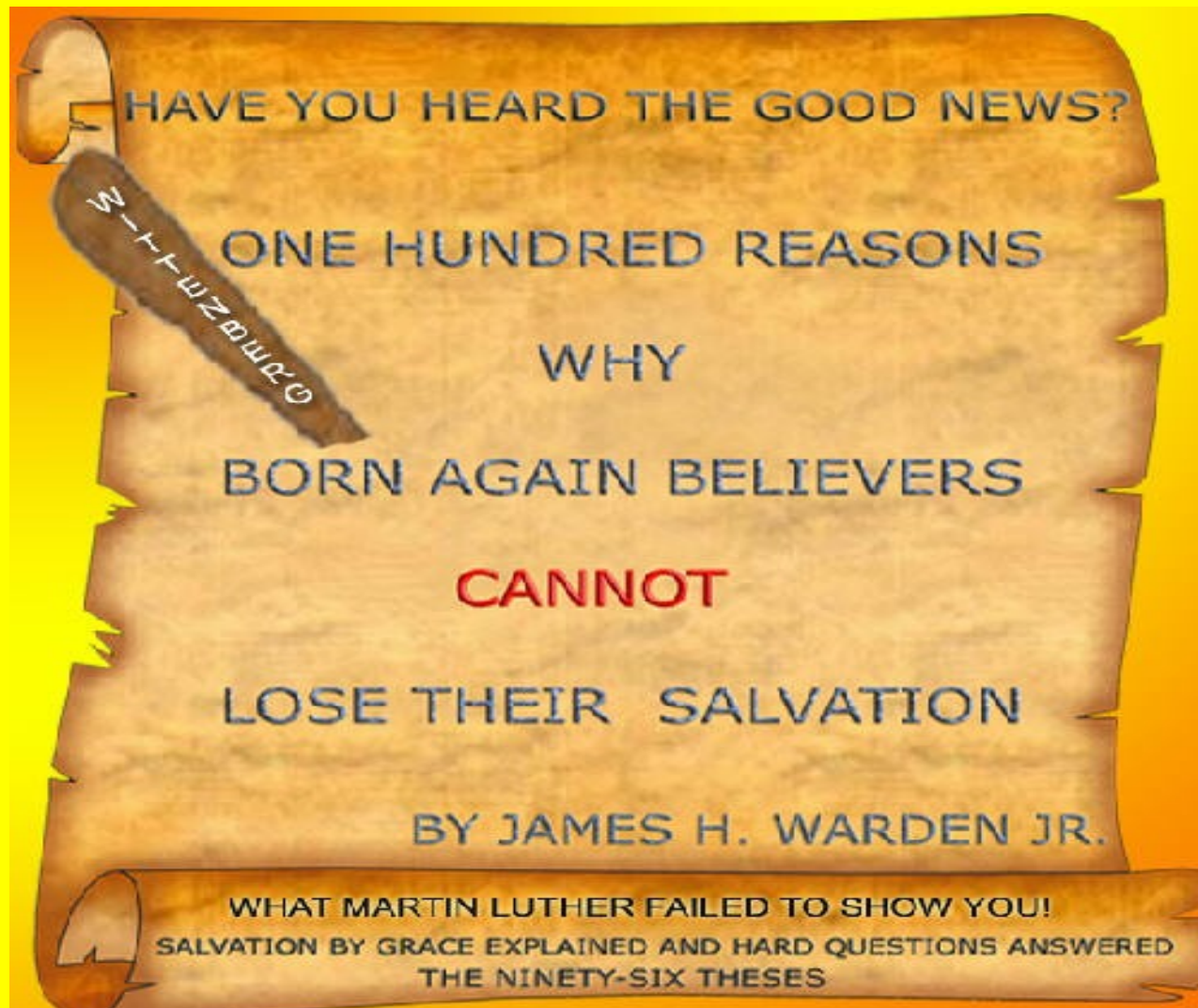
